

A Newly Sprouted Seed

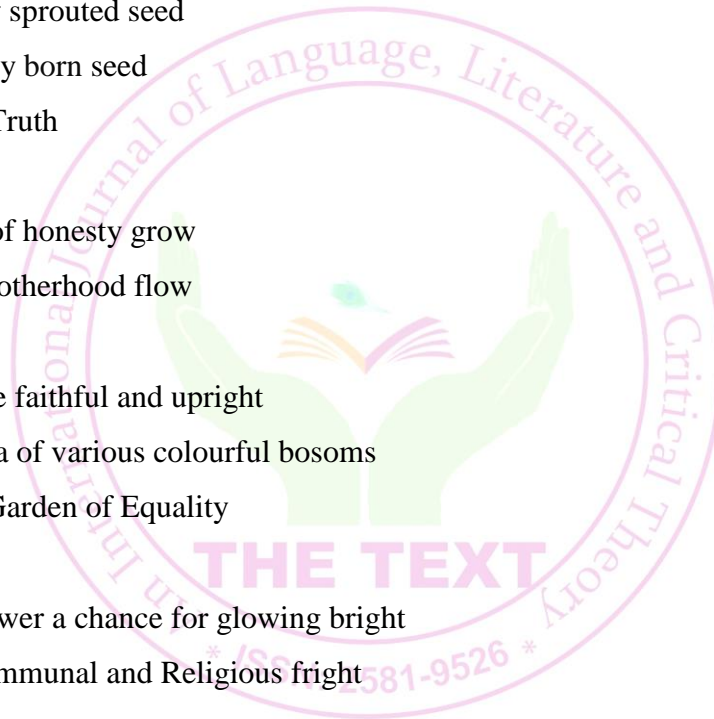
